

LATEST CAMPAIGNING GUIDANCE FROM THE LABOUR PARTY, 21 DECEMBER 2020

Any national health advice or local lockdown imposed by your Local Authority supersedes all advice given here.

Leafletting	<p>Ensure you have downloaded the NHS app and have it activated before starting.</p> <p>If you or anyone in your household has been told to self-isolate, you must not go leafletting.</p> <p>Wash your hands thoroughly before going out.</p> <p>Don't leaflet in groups with anyone from outside your household.</p> <p>Don't stop and talk to people. Be polite and courteous if approached and maintain a 2m distance.</p> <p>Use hand sanitizer or gloves. Wear a face mask to reassure the public and to keep yourself and others as safe as possible.</p> <p>Wash your hands thoroughly on return.</p>		Not allowed.
Door knocking	<p>Door knocking may only take place with the permission of your regional office, with this decision taken in line with the guidance and specific local circumstances in the areas concerned. Before any plans are made to take a team out door knocking please contact your regional office to confirm this is allowed and for a full briefing. You must do this before you and/or a team goes out door knocking.</p>	Not allowed.	Not allowed.

	<p>Please ensure you are adhering to government advice on social distancing at all times.</p> <p>If you or anyone in your household has been told to self-isolate you must not go campaigning.</p> <p>Do not go out door knocking in groups of more than 6.</p> <p>Do not meet in groups of more than 6. Arrange separate door knocking sessions and meeting points or stagger start times if you have more than 6 volunteers.</p> <p>Issue road groups and literature to team leaders in advance.</p> <p>All team members must wear a mask, carry hand sanitizer and wash hands before and after a session to protect yourself and the public.</p> <p>Ensure you take the names and phone numbers of everyone on a round for contact tracing.</p> <p>Please ensure you are adhering to government advice on social distancing at all times (2m but 1m in some circumstances in England; we would ask</p>

	<p>whilst campaigning you adhere to 2m where possible).</p> <p>Think about the areas where you are door knocking: do not door-knock where social distancing is not possible for example residential complexes and flats.</p> <p>Where possible use the door knocking app to allow social distancing in the team. If this is not possible, team members should be issued with separate sheets as out lined in the regional briefing.</p> <p>Once you knock on a person's door, you should then move at least two metres away from the door.</p> <p>Do not shout or talk loudly as the risk of spread increases.</p> <p>Before the session, ensure that all team members have taken part in the regional briefing.</p> <p>Hold a briefing at the start of each session. You may need to stagger the start time of each session so that you can do this in a safe way. Our script may have changed since last time you went door knocking.</p>
